"After Midnight Before Dawn" by David Campton is based around six characters who are waiting death, having been sentenced for witchcraft, the period being late 1600s or early 1700s. Only one character remains unmoved by the situation and claims that she will not hang. The others conclude that she is indeed a witch and has Satan's protection. Four of them beg her to tell them how they too can gain this protection, while the Girl protests. By the end of the play it is obvious that two will not hang on the gallows, but the others will, at dawn.

This play, which is usually performed by older actors, is a great challenge for this young cast, whose ages range from 15 to 17.
